As the year draws to a close, Emily and I are working to close the 2022 books and prepare for 2023. At this point, with December not yet reported, our church operating revenue is ahead of budget and our expenses are below budget, mostly due to the use of Supply Priests for over half of 2022. Thank you all for your support this year. I will not report numbers this newsletter since they will be in the Annual Report.

The mission of this group is to serve others whether it is within our parish, our local communities, our state and throughout the world. The group holds two major fund raisers during the year which allows us to carry out this

mission. A few examples in which the group has given support are: On-going support of quarterly gas cards to the Priest, the purchase of coffee and lemonade for coffee hours, provide baptism and graduation cakes, purchased Christmas poinsettias for the altar, purchased sets of tablecloths and the stove for the parish hall, donated funds for the church's technology, ongoing support for the annual Gala and Golf Tournament for Guardian Angels, as well as birthday gifts for residents at the Care Center. We continue to support CAER food shelf, Open Doors for Youth, Episcopal Relief fund, Heifer International, Feed My Starving Children, the Priest's Discretionary Fund and have provided treats for Confirmation and Mother's Day. In the past funds were used to assist in paying the property taxes, provided nutritional supplements for a church member, provided assistance for a parish family who incurred major medical bills and purchased a riding lawn mower for the church.

We have a fun time when we get together, enjoy conversation and share a laugh or two. We're a friendly, welcoming bunch who extend a warm invite to come a check us out!

Mirzada Family Update

The Mirzada family left Afghanistan when the US pulled all troops out of that country. Any Afghani and their families working with US forces were in grave danger when the Taliban took control of Afghanistan. They were evacuated under an emergency provision from Congress which failed to grant these evacuees immigrant or even refugee status. Now here, they have two years to apply for and receive official status either as Asylum seekers or Refugees, at which point they may be granted legal residency and begin to work toward permanent US residency and Green Card status. They came to Elk River on November 1st. They had been in Minneapolis and helped by the Minnesota Council of Churches and three Episcopal churches in the Twin Cities. Another Afghani family in Otsego brought them up here so they could help them.

We were contacted by one of the Episcopal churches in Minneapolis to see if we could provide some help for them. You may recall a couple of announcements on Sunday. Our Women's Group bought and delivered three twin beds for them. We contacted United Church of Christ and Elk River Lutheran and asked them to join us in helping this family. So far UCC has donated several items. Last Wednesday, December 28th, Nancy Ingram planned and organized bringing much needed furniture, household items and other needed items to the family. Nancy, with the help of Ben Bastyr, Dave Raitz and Sandy Sisson brought the family additional beds, living room furniture, TV's, rugs, winter clothing, dishes and much more.

The family is so grateful! They insisted upon feeding those who brought things. The younger children hugged the helpers and one told Nancy "I love you". The adults helped and said thank you over and over. If you are interested in helping, please contact Nancy Ingram for more information.

Another positive outcome of this effort is that the United Church of Christ people we have been working with have told us how much they miss working and worshiping with our congregation as they used to do in years past. Something to think about!
